The Open Choice program is intended to improve academic achievement; reduce racial, ethnic and economic isolation; and provide a choice of educational programs for public school students.

Eligibility

- ◆ Student must be attending a Hartford public school (K-12).
- ◆ Student must be a Hartford resident.

The Capitol Region Choice Program is part of the statewide Open Choice program that allows urban students to attend public schools in nearby suburban towns and suburban students to attend public schools in a nearby urban center.
