Essay Question

Aquaculture began in Asia and has evolved through the sharing of information between diverse groups worldwide. Developed countries characterized as industrial, first world, and economically wealthy, as well as developing third or fourth world nations that are non-industrial and economically poor, could benefit from this growing science. The practice of aquaculture ranges from the smallest villages to the largest cities throughout the world.

Despite the unequal distribution of wealth and power throughout the world, all people are dependent on the efficient use of natural resources. In order to help sustain the rapidly growing world population, alternative methods of food production and distribution may be necessary. The science of aquaculture may provide a means of food production that has a lower impact on the natural environment than methods currently in practice.

Exploring Diversity through Aquaculture provides an opportunity to study aquaculture while interacting with persons from diverse backgrounds. **What are the global benefits of studying this area of science, and what personal benefits are to be gained from working with individuals from diverse backgrounds?**
