The Assessment of Program Practices Tool (APT), developed by the National Institute on Out-of-School Time (NIOST), is designed for afterschool programs working on continuous quality improvement.

The APT tool is ideal for 21st Century Community Learning Centers by providing a way for after-school programs to focus on assessing specific, observable practices. It also contains a self-assessment questionnaire to examine aspects of program quality that happen behind the scenes.

Participants in the 21st CCLC practitioners training will:

- Explore principles that guide program improvement
- Learn to use the APT through video practice
- Practice using the APT for program improvement
- Learn how to use APT results to improve your after-school program
- Discuss ways to provide feedback to frontline staff
