Dear Applicant,

Are you a student who has the ability to lead, a strong academic standing, the ability to work successfully with others, and an interest in and a commitment to community service?

If so, the Capitol Region Interdistrict Leadership Academy (CRILA) invites you to apply for a position in the 2017-2018 Academy. CRILA funding is partially provided by a grant from the Connecticut State Department of Education.* There is a small cost to students attending the program of \$650.00 to cover transportation costs.

Successful applicants will meet several times during the spring of 2017 and will travel together to Leadville, Colorado for an Outward Bound experience from June 17 to June 24, 2017. During the 2017-2018 school year, Academy members will meet regularly to work on a variety of community service projects and to study ethical and collaborative leadership.

Students are selected based on their current academic standing, their leadership resume, and an essay which provides examples of their leadership experience and demonstrates their desire to be a participant in the CRILA program.

If you believe you are a good candidate for CRILA, we encourage you to submit a complete application by Friday, **March 17, 2017**^

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

A complete application must include the following documents in a single envelope:

- Student Information Cover Sheet (next page)
- Essay (see requirements below)
- Resume
- Unofficial Transcript (provided by your guidance counselor)
- Copy of a Photo I.D. (e.g. license, passport, high school I.D.)

Application documents should be single-sided and without staples.

LEADERSHIP ESSAY REQUIREMENTS

Please include an 800-1,000-word, typed essay addressing the following prompts:

- Reflect on your experiences as a leader. Identify and explain how these personal experiences demonstrate your leadership skills.
- Explain why you want to participate in the Leadership Academy.

In addition, address at least one of the following questions in your essay:

- What will you bring to the Leadership Academy?
- What in your mind are the qualities of a good leader?
- Identify a leader who has significantly influenced you. How has this person inspired you?

Essays may not exceed 1,000 words.
