- Explain why you want to participate in the Leadership Academy.

In addition, address at least one of the following questions in your essay:

- What will you bring to the Leadership Academy?
- What in your mind are the qualities of a good leader?
- Identify a leader who has significantly influenced you. How has this person inspired you?

Essays may not exceed 1,000 words.
