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Description: In this workshop, World Language instructors will learn methods in modeling and integrating correct target language use as they instruct, structure, facilitate, and guide target language learners through the learning process of language acquisition. Participants will learn how to structure instructional time and classroom space to promote target language practice. Additionally, participants will: 1) learn how to facilitate and apply methods for the movement and active participation of students; 2) learn how to facilitate centers-based learning and how to guide students' communication with each other; and 3) review various performance tasks, performance rubrics, and assessments. Participants will leave with a "roadmap"/"framework" that will assist them in guiding their WL learners to develop competence in communicating effectively and interacting with cultural understanding.
