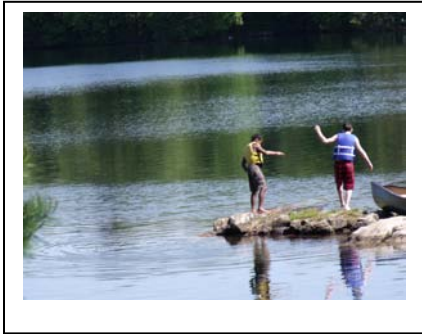


CREC POLARIS CENTER SUMMER PROGRAMS



SUMMER BLAST:

July 5 – August 12, 2011

Monday – Friday 8:30AM - 2:30PM

Breakfast and lunch included. Choose which weeks you want to attend (2-wk. minimum)!
Transportation available within a 10 mile radius of East Hartford.

A six-week a summer program for teenagers in 7th-10th grade, providing them with an opportunity to participate in activities, trips and community service that emphasize experiential hands-on and adventure-based learning and fun! Structured days, supportive staff, an emphasis on building positive relationships with adults and peers and broadening their horizons.

Activities may include hiking, biking, ROPES course on campus, canoeing, swimming, trips to the beach and state parks and community service (day care center, soup kitchen, shelter, horse farm, Food Share). Last year's trips and museum visits included: Basketball Hall of Fame, Thimble Islands Cruise, Mashantucket Indian Museum, Science Center, Beardsley Zoo, New Britain Museum of Art, Brownstone Adventure Park in Portland, Tubing on Farmington River, Rose's Berry Farm and tours of colleges (UConn, ECSU, MCC).

Summer Blast, the perfect summer experience for teenagers too old for "babysitters", too young to be on their own all day, or who are not yet ready/able to have a summer job.
