CREC-TABS is pleased to be able to offer Virtual Learning Academy (VLA) as an option for Connecticut students to help them meet their graduation requirements. This online learning option offers credit recovery courses that fit all learning styles for students in grades K-12. The program's easy structure and training provides greater flexibility for districts trying to meet the educational challenges of all of their students.

Program Highlights:

- Annual student licenses can be purchased for \$450 per student. Students can take as many or as few classes as needed. There are no membership fees or minimum purchases.
- Training takes only about an hour for district teachers and the dedicated "point of contact".
- Schools do not need to provide release time for faculty to teach the classes. The classes are already created and available to take online.
- Curriculum, aligned with national standards, is available in: Math, English, Social Studies, Science, Fine Arts, Business/Technology, Foreign Language, ACT Prep and Student Leadership.
