ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY SERVICES FOR 2011-2012

CREC's Assistive Technology (AT) services provide districts with customized and flexible support for AT to meet the various needs of your district. CREC's AT services include, but are not limited to:

- AT technical assistance and training to build capacity within district
- AT and augmentative and alternative communication (AAC) evaluations
- Membership in CREC's AT Consortium which includes:
 - An AT equipment lending library – including iPads and iTouches
 - Six AT consortium meetings with CEUs provided (districts may send up to three participants). Dates: *10/25, 11/18/2011, 1/25, snow date 1/27, 2/28, snow date 2/29, 4/10, & 5/22/2012*
 - RESC Alliance quarterly AT newsletter

Assistive Technology Services (may also be customized to district need):

Option 1 - \$15,000

- 18 days of AT services, tailored to district needs (includes AT evaluations, technical assistance and professional development)
- Assistive Technology Consortium membership

Option 2 - \$11,000

- 12 days of AT services, tailored to district need
- Assistive Technology Consortium membership

Option 3 - \$7,500

- 8 days of AT services, tailored to district need
- Assistive Technology Consortium membership

Option 4 - \$4,500

- 4 days of AT services, tailored to district need
- Assistive Technology Consortium membership
