Application Process

- Interviews are part of the admission process for this program. Following a screening of all applications, virtual interviews will be conducted to determine which applicants will be admitted to the program. You will be notified if you are chosen for an interview.
- Tuition for the AARC program is \$9800, excluding the application fee. You are also responsible for purchasing books from Amazon, materials, exam fees, certification fees, and laboratory fee. (Payment of 50% of tuition is due on or before the first day of Phase I in June online through CSS. The remaining 50% of tuition is due prior to Phase II in September).
- Candidates that do not complete program requirements within the 14-month timeline are subject to administrative withdraw processes or a \$500 late fee, which may be incurred every six (6) months the program is not completed.

- 1. Go to https://selfservice.crec.org/css/citizens/OtherServices/
- 2. Expand the plus symbol next to the service categories to find the service desired.
