CREC Museum Academy: 2016 – 2017
Capital Projects Fund
Construction Division

The CREC Museum Academy has an approved school construction grant of \$55,327,963. The original school construction grant application was approved by the State in June 2011, and was revised in November 2015 to reflect final project costs.

The school site is located on 14.17 acres at 11 Turkey Hill Road, Bloomfield. The 75,000 square foot facility will accommodate 522 students, grades Pre-K to 5.

The architect, Smith Edwards McCoy, has completed the final plans and the professional cost estimates for Phase 3.

The project will be reviewed in phases according to the Department of Administrative Services' (DAS) guidelines, as follows:

- Phase 1 of 4 Building Demolition
- Phase 2 of 4 Building Construction
- Phase 3 of 4 Furniture, Fixtures and Equipment
- Phase 4 of 4 Playscape

In addition to these four phases, the project also has "soft costs", which include architectural design services, other professional services, site acquisition and contingency.

<u>RECOMMENDED ACTION</u>: Approve the submission to DAS for Phase 3 – Furniture, Fixtures and Equipment (final plans and the professional cost estimate) for the CREC Museum Academy project.

Entitlement Grants: 2016-2017 Special Revenue Fund and General Fund Division of Choice Programs

CREC has been awarded the following federal entitlement grants through the State Department of Education:

- Title I, Regular Part A Improving Basic Programs Operated By Local Educational Agencies
- Title II, Part A Teachers and Principal Training & Recruitment
- Title III, Part A English Language Acquisition and Language Enhancement

Title I – Part A funds are used, primarily, to provide supplemental instruction in literacy, math and science to students who are failing or at risk of failing. Funds are used for teacher professional development and for scientifically-based research intervention strategies and materials, computer-based literacy and math programs.

Title II – Part A funds are used for facilitators and mentors working with magnet school teachers in the Teaching Evaluation and Mentoring Program (TEAM) and workshops for teachers to create individualized plans for struggling students.

Title III – Part A funds are used to provide direct services to students and consultation services to staff in CREC magnet schools and other school districts. This is a consortium grant managed by CREC. Districts awarded less than \$10,000 must enter a consortium.
