

Community Relations

Loitering or Causing Disturbance

All visitors must register in the office of the school principal. Staff members should be alert to the possibility of unauthorized visitors and promptly report any concerns to the principal. Any person shall be considered loitering on school grounds when they remain in or about a school building or grounds, without reporting to the facilities' main office, without relationship involving custody of or responsibility for a student, and/or remaining on the property without permission to be there.
