Electronic Devices

The School Principal may grant written permission for such possession and use of a paging device by a student if the student or his parent or guardian establishes to the satisfaction of the Principal that a reasonable basis exists for the possession and use of the device.

The CREC Council shall consider the special needs of parents and students in determining whether to restrict the student possession or use of cellular mobile telephones.

Students shall not possess or use a laser pointer, unless under teacher supervision for instructional purposes. Students may not use a remotely activated paging device or cellular mobile telephone during the school day.
