Naming of Facility

It shall be the prerogative of the CREC Council to establish the need and appropriateness of naming or renaming any school building, including all outdoor and indoor areas or facilities of a school, or any part thereof. In fulfilling this responsibility, the Council will make every effort to respect community preferences.

School buildings, areas, facilities, or parts thereof shall be named for a geographical landmark; an event; or a person who:

- Has attained prominence locally or nationally;
- Is of importance in history, education, science, the arts, government, or sports;
- Was a leader in an endeavor in the community or the State of Connecticut;
- Is a CREC former employee who has made major contributions to the district above and beyond professional obligations.

School buildings, areas, facilities, or parts thereof will not be named after persons who are currently employed by CREC or are active in its operations, or who currently hold any public office.

When naming or renaming a school building, area, facility, or part thereof, the Council shall direct the Executive Director to establish a committee, subject to Council approval, comprised of the Executive Director or designee, the building principal/program director, faculty members, parents, community members, and, if appropriate, students, to consider name recommendations for consideration by the Council. Opportunities for public input will be made available prior to the committee's recommendation to the Council. The Council retains the right to make the final determination in the naming or renaming of school buildings, areas or facilities.
