As we approach the end of the school year, we would like to share a few important reminders and updates to help ensure a smooth and safe transportation experience for all students and their families.

Summer School Transportation



Will your child be attending summer school this year? If they will need transportation, please contact your child's school as soon as possible. The school will work with you to arrange the details.

Transportation Stipend Deadline: June 15, 2026



The eligibility criteria apply only to:

- PK students who live outside of Hartford
- Students who live outside the Transportation Zone

For these students, the parent/guardian is responsible for transporting their student to and from school throughout the entire school year. In return, families receive a stipend of \$5.00 per day, based on their student's attendance.

Online applications are available every school year from October to June 15. For the current 2025-2026 school year, the deadline is June 15, 2026.

Please note it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to complete and submit the application each school year if eligible for the stipend.

Moving This Summer? Don't Forget to Update Your Address!

If your family moves over the summer and your child will continue attending a magnet school, technical high school, or an Open Choice school in a nearby district, please remember to update your address.

You must contact your child's school to provide proof of residency and share your new address. Once your residency and address are verified, the school will submit the **Change Request form** on your behalf.

Change Requests (Bus Stop Change) for the 2026-27 School Year

- Bus Stop Changes: To request a different bus stop, see [RSCO Transportation Forms](#) to create a ticket, or call the RSCO Office at **860-524-4077**.
- In preparation for the 2026-27 school year, if your child will be using a different bus stop than they use now, please notify the RSCO Transportation office. If you do not notify the RSCO Transportation office, your child's bus stop will remain the same. If you have any questions please contact our office.

- Promptly notify RSCO Transportation and the student's school of any changes to the primary contact person or if you need to add any additional individuals to the student contact list.
